The Merriam-Webster dictionary defines "rally" in several ways. First, as a transitive verb, it means: 1a: to muster for a common purpose; b: to recall to order; 2a: to arouse for action b: to rouse from depression or weakness. Secondly, as an intransitive verb, it means: 1: to come together again to renew an effort; 2: to join in a common cause; 3: recover, rebound; 4: to engage in a rally.
